Love, love, love; the gospel in a word is love; Love your neighbor as yourself; love, love, love.

This is a round I learned when I was young. I don't remember the specific date, but it may have been on a church family retreat to Shelter Island back in the 70s. Self-dating aside, the ease of which the melody is sung, different voices starting at different places and yielding harmony still touch me all these years later.

It reminds me that in a congregation we all come together from different places to embark on a shared journey. Some things we have in common: a mutual desire to follow Jesus and a sense of purpose as a congregation. Other things we do not: we are different ages, have attended different schools, worked different jobs, had different life experiences and are likely at different places on our faith journey. Both what is shared in common (the melody) and the differences (the harmony) are needed; and together they are beautiful.

As we move into 2023 (and Lent), may we know the gifts of a Song sung in a round. May we know the gifts melody: a shared song that reminds of our common direction. May we know the gifts of harmony: the variety of gifts that exist and strengthen our family of faith. And may we know the love and beauty that come from encountering both.

"Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?"

[Jesus] said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." This is the greatest and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself." On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets." ~Matthew 22:36-40
