

Emanuel Lutheran Church Council Meeting Update, August 20, 2025

YTD Budget Income: \$51,758.91 YTD Budget Expense: \$39,248.27 YTD Gain: \$12,510.64

- Budget plans to start in September. Teams need to provide their input to Sharon.


